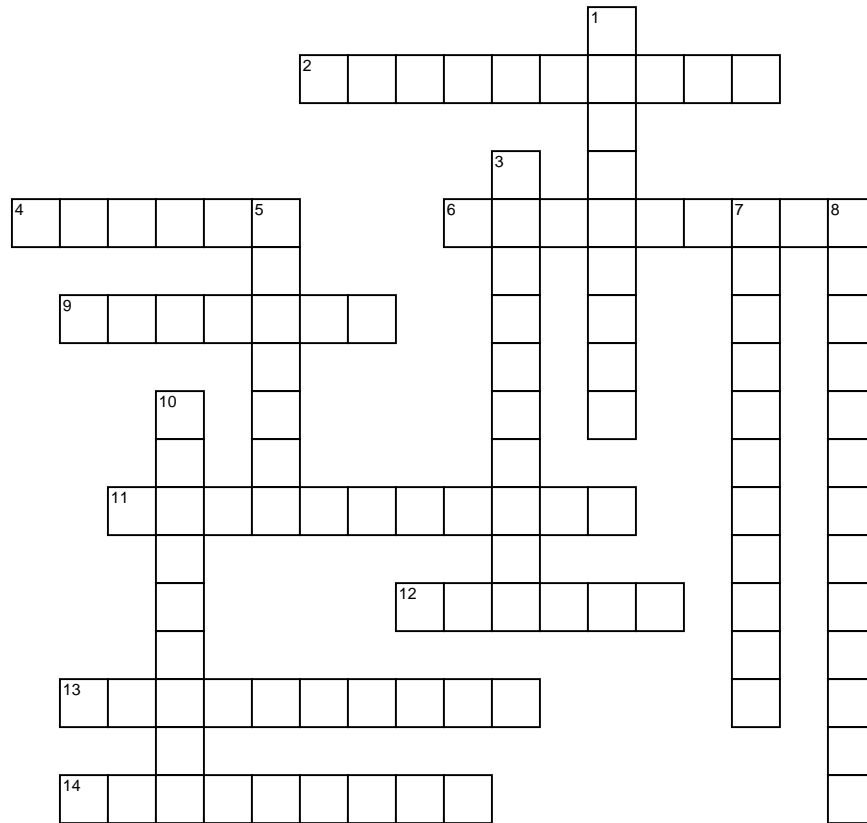

ACROSS

- 2 A microscopic bacterium like organism that lacks a cell wall and appears filamentous.
- 4 A virus like particle that lacks the outer protein coat of a virus particle.
- 6 Pathogen invades the plant tissue.
- 9 Submicroscopic, sub cellular particles that require a host cell in which to multiply.
- 11 Process of getting inside the plant, it may be an active or passive process.
- 12 Organism with no chlorophyll that reproduces by means of structure called spores and usually has filamentous growth.
- 13 To keep from occurring; stop.
- 14 Disease causing organisms.

- 1 A single-celled microscopic organism with cell walls and no chlorophyll.
- 3 Period of development during which the pathogen undergoes changes to a form that can penetrate or infect the new host plant.
- 5 Any condition of a plant that impairs normal physiological functions.
- 7 The introduction of the pathogens to the host plant tissue.
- 8 Diseases caused by abiotic agents.
- 10 To deal with (a disease) in order to relieve or cure.
