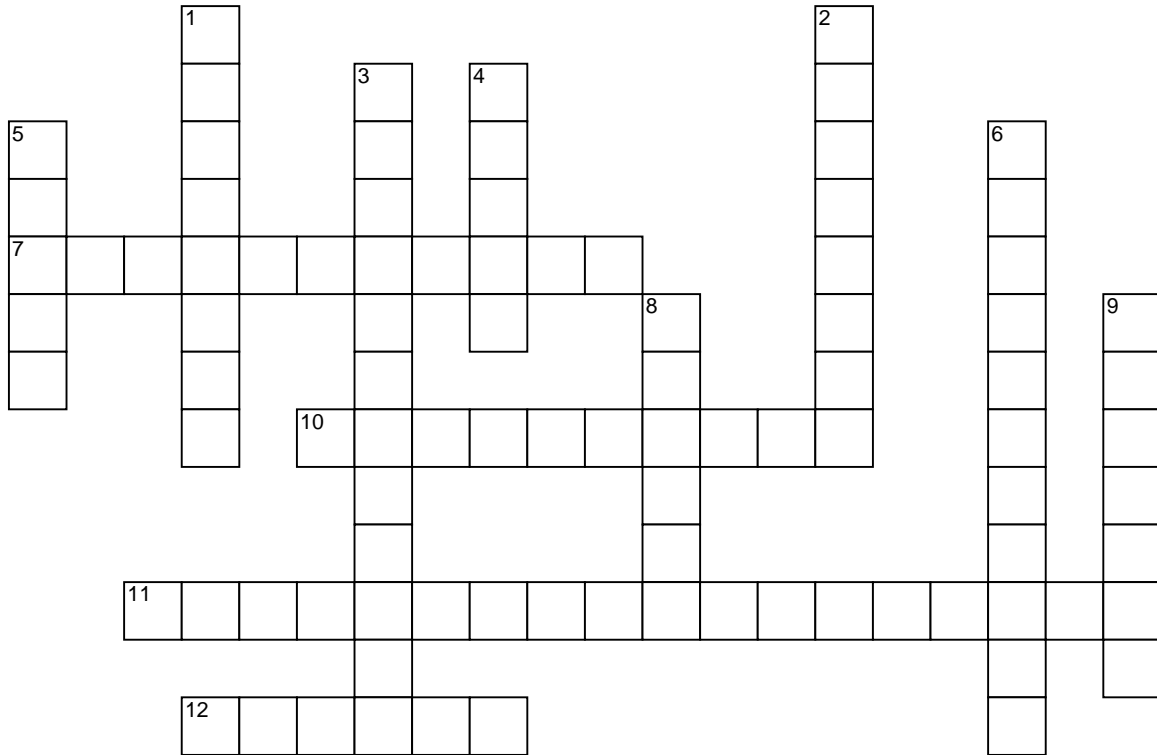

- 5 A severe distention of the abdomen by gas
- 6 A magnesium-deficiency disease of cattle
- 8 A deficiency of hemoglobin, iron, or red-blood cells.
- 9 An inflammation of the tissue that attaches the hoof to the foot
