

## Lesson 5.2 -- Diseased



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### ACROSS

- 1 A temperature higher than normal in animals,
- 3 The process of identifying a disease by examination and study of its symptoms.
- 4 A disease the runs a short, severe course
- 7 To introduce a substance into the body of an animal or plant by mechanical means.
- 10 Designating early or mild stages of a disease before signs or symptoms are noticeable; symptomless or low-grade infections.
- 12 The number of heartbeats per unit of time usually expressed as beats per minute.
- 14 Situated or occurring beneath the skin.
- 16 Within the muscles.
- 20 The rate or frequency of breathing, expressed as the number of breaths per minute.
- 21 Taken by mouth.
- 22 Any deviation from a normal state of health in plants, animals, or people, which temporarily impairs vital functions
- 23 Fully aware and attentive; wide-awake; keen

- 2 Abnormal lung sounds in cases of pneumonia or lung inflammation.
- 3 A fluid dose of medication given by introducing it into the mouth, usually with a dose syringe.
- 5 The state of being contented; satisfaction; ease of mind.
- 6 Any animal disease that can be transmitted from animals to other animals and to people.
- 8 To care for a sick animal or diseased plant by giving it proper attention and medication.
- 9 The degree of heat in a living body.
- 11 A disease in which symptoms of the disease are expressed
- 13 Applied externally to a particular part of the body.
- 14 A perceptible change in any part of the body, which indicates disease. A group of symptoms that, considered together, characterize a disease syndrome.
- 15 The state wherein all body parts of plants, animals, and people are functioning normally.
- 17 A disease that is marked by long duration and frequent recurrence.
- 18 Signs or Index of essential body functions, comprising heart rate, body temperature, and respiration.
- 19 —A large pill for dosing animals.
